 This bill enables a municipaltiy to enact an ordinance prohibiting the operation of motorcycles in excess of the federal noise level standard. The bill does not require the municipalities throughout the State to adopt the standard. The bill does not require the State Police, municipal law enforcement agencies or service station operators to purchase expensive sound measuring equipment.

If a municipality chooses to enact and enforce a motorcycle noise level standard, only that particular municipality would have to purchase a sound measuring device.

This bill insures that the motorcycle noise level standard adopted by any municipality is a uniform standard and in compliance with the federal standard. A motorcyclist who complies with the standard in one municipality will be incompliance with standards adopted by any other municipality.

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
