24 25 26	4. Safety seat belts. In addition to the stan- dards in subsection 1, safety seat belts on 1966 and subsequent models shall be inspected to insure that:
27 28	A. The motor vehicle has the proper number of safety seat belts for that make and model; and
29 30	B. Each safety seat belt shall be fully func- tional.

32 33	§2521-A. Suspension of license for failure to in- spect safety seat belts

1	If an official inspection station fails to in	-
2	spect safety seat belts in any motor vehicle as re	-
3	quired in section 2503, subsection 4, the Administra	-
4	tive Court Judge, after a hearing, shall suspend th	e
5	license issued to that official inspection statio	n
6	for a period of one year.	

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to require inspection 9 stations to inspect all seat belts in a motor vehicle 10 when the vehicle is inspected to insure that the ve-11 hicle has the correct number of seat belts and that 12 all are in functioning order. The bill provides that 13 any inspection station failing to inspect the seat 14 belts will lose its inspection license for one year.
