HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 467, L.D. 616,  
Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Law Enforcement Officers  
and Public Office Holding."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the  
following:

'Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §1503-A is enacted to read:

§1503-A. Municipal officers

No member of the State Police, or person with the  
power to arrest, may serve as a municipal officer as  
defined in Title 30, section 1901, subsection 7.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section  
3 the following:

'Sec. 4. 30 MRSA §2366 is enacted to read:

§2366. Municipal officers

No person with the power to arrest may serve as a  
municipal officer as defined in section 1901, subsec-  
tion 7.

Sec. 5. Transition clause. Any person holding  
office upon the effective date of this Act may remain  
in that office until the expiration of their current  
term.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-  
tions to read consecutively.
