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Resolve, Concerning Blackfly Control.

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Appropriation; blackfly control. Resolved: That  
there is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
Department of Environmental Protection the sum of  
\$30,000 for fiscal year 1985-86 for the purpose of  
supporting research on blackfly biology, on  
quantifying the adverse economic impact caused by the  
blackflies, on the economic benefits that might  
accure from their control and on environmentally safe  
control of blackflies.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this resolve is to appropriate funds to the Department of Environmental Protection to conduct a study on blackflies and their possible control.

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
