IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
AN ACT Concerning Uniform Teacher Evaluation Standards.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
20-A MRSA §13802 is enacted to read:
§13802. Teacher evaluation standards
1. Department to establish standards. The department shall establish statewide standards, criteria and procedures for evaluation of the professional performance of teachers employed in any school administrative unit within the State.
2. Use of standards. Each school administrative unit within the State shall employ the standards established pursuant to subsection 1 for the evaluation of the professional performance of any teacher employed by that school administrative unit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to establish statewide standards, criteria and procedures to be used by school administrative units in the evaluation of teacher performance.

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
