17 AN ACT Concerning Uniform Teacher Evaluation

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §13802 is enacted to read:

23 §13802. Teacher evaluation standards

24 1. Department to establish standards. The de-
25 partment shall establish statewide standards, crite-
26 ria and procedures for evaluation of the professional
27 performance of teachers employed in any school admin-
28 istrative unit within the State.

29 2. Use of standards. Each school administrative
30 unit within the State shall employ the standards es-
31 tablished pursuant to subsection 1 for the evaluation
32 of the professional performance of any teacher em-
33 ployed by that school administrative unit.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to establish statewide standards, criteria and procedures to be used by school administrative units in the evaluation of teacher performance.

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
