21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §2241-G, sub-§2, ¶B, as repealed and re-
24 placed by PL 1983, c. 850, §4, is repealed and the
25 following enacted in its place:

26 B. Except where a longer period of suspension is
27 otherwise provided by law, the Secretary of State
28 shall, without preliminary hearing, suspend the
29 provisional license of any person who has not at-
30 tained the legal drinking age in this State:

31 (1) Until that person attains the legal
32 drinking age in this State if the Secretary
33 of State receives a record of that person's
34 conviction or adjudication for violation of
35 section 1312-B or 1312-C or Title 15, sec-
36 tion 3103, subsection 1, paragraph F; or
