21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 28 MRSA §304-A is enacted to read:

24 §304-A. Exception to credit restrictions

25 A wholesale distributor of malt liquor and table  
26 wine licensed under chapter 15, shall extend a  
27 7-working day credit period for the payment of in-  
28 voices to any retail distributor licensed under sec-  
29 tion 751. A wholesale licensee may require cash pay-  
30 ment upon delivery to a retail licensee under the  
31 following conditions:

32 1. The retail licensee has a documented history  
33 of late payment;
