17 AN ACT to Require Guides for Hunters who are
18 not United States Citizens.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§6-A is enacted to
23 read:

24 6-A. Alien hunters to be guided. An alien hunt-
25 er license shall not be valid unless the alien hunt-
26 er, or party of alien hunters, which may include no
27 more than 8 alien hunters, is under the sponsorship
28 of a licensed guide while hunting.

29 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7301, sub-§2, as repealed and
30 replaced by PL 1979, c. 543, §26, is amended to read:

31 2. Eligibility. No person may act as a guide un-
32 less he is a United States citizen and until he is 18
33 years of age or older and has procured a license to
34 guide from the commissioner.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require guide services for alien hunters while hunting in the State.

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
