SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT
"A" to S.P. 247, L.D. 642, Bill, "AN ACT to Create
the Advisory Commission on Radioactive Waste to Re-
place the Low-level Waste Commission."

Amend the amendment in section 9 by inserting at
the end the following:

'All accrued expenditures, assets, liabilities,
balances or allocations, transfers, revenues or other
available funds in the account of the Low-level Waste
Siting Commission shall be reallocated to the Advis-
ory Commission on Radioactive Waste on the date of
the first meeting of that commission. All contracts
and agreements in effect with the Low-level Waste
Siting Commission shall remain in effect following
establishment of the Advisory Commission on Radioac-
tive Waste, unless rescinded, terminated or modified
by that commission.

Sec. 10. Allocation. The following funds are
allocated from the Radioactive Waste Evaluation Fund
to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to provide an
3 allocation from the Radioactive Waste Evaluation Fund
4 to the Advisory Commission on Radioactive Waste and
5 to the Department of Environmental Protection for
6 commission activities in the last half of fiscal year
7 1986 and fiscal year 1987. The amendment also clari-
8 fies and allocates funds for the transition from the
