17 AN ACT to Provide for Mandatory Loss of
18 Operator License for Minors Operating
19 Under the Influence.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §2241-G, sub-§2, ¶B, as repealed and re-
24 placed by PL 1983, c. 850, §4, is amended to read:

25 B. Except where a longer period of suspension is
26 otherwise provided by law, the Secretary of State
27 shall suspend ~~for a period of one year~~, without
28 preliminary hearing, the provisional license of
29 any person who has not attained his 20th birthday
30 until that person attains his 21st birthday:

31 (1) As to whom there is received a record
32 of conviction or adjudication for violation
33 of section 1312-B or 1312-C or Title 15,
34 section 3103, subsection 1, paragraph F; or

1 (2) As to whom he determines has operated
2 or attempted to operate a motor vehicle
3 while having 0.02% or more by weight of al-
4cohol in his blood.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to provide that any
7 minor whose license is suspended for any alcohol re-
8 lated offense involving the operation of a motor ve-
9 hicle shall not regain that license until he reaches
10 21 years of age.
