17 AN ACT to Close Ragged Stream to Caribou Lake
18 to the Taking of Smelts.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶A, as reenacted by PL
23 1979, c. 723, §25, is amended to read:

24 A. A person may take smelts at any time by the
25 use of a dipnet in the usual and ordinary way in
26 inland waters or portions thereof which are natu-
27 rally free of ice, and where the taking of smelts
28 is not prohibited by rules of the commissioner.
29 Notwithstanding this paragraph, no person may
30 take smelts by the use of a dipnet in the waters
31 of Ragged Stream to Caribou Lake;

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to close Ragged
3 Stream to Caribou Lake to the taking of smelts.

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
