17 AN ACT to Permit the Secretary of State to  
18 Issue Work-restricted Drivers' Licenses  
19 to First Time OUI Offenders.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 29 MRSA §1312-D, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

24 5-A. Work-restricted license. Notwithstanding  
25 this section, section 1312-B, 1312-C or Title 15,  
26 section 3314, upon receipt by the Secretary of State  
27 of a petition for a work-restricted license by any  
28 person whose license or right to operate a motor ve-  
29 hicle has been suspended as a result of a conviction  
30 or adjudication of a violation of section 1312-B,  
31 1312-C or Title 15, section 3103, subsection 1, para-  
32 graph F, which violation is that person's first such  
33 violation within a 6-year period, the Secretary of  
34 State may issue a work-restricted license to that  
35 person. The issuance of such a license shall be con-  
36 ditioned upon a showing by the petitioner by clear

1 and convincing evidence that such a license is neces-  
2 sary to operate a motor vehicle between the residence  
3 and a place of employment or to operate a motor vehi-  
4 cle in the scope of employment, as determined by the  
5 Secretary of State, and that no alternative means of  
6 transportation is available.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to permit the Secre-  
9 tary of State to issue work-restricted licenses to  
10 first time OUI offenders.
