18 Social Services Transportation Review
19 Committee.

21 Sec. 1. Social Services Transportation Review
22 Committee Established. Resolved: That a Social Ser-
23 vices Transportation Review Committee is established
24 with membership to be appointed as follows: Three
25 Legislators; one representative from the Maine Com-
26 mittee on Aging; one representative from the Maine
27 Human Services Council; one representative from the
28 Bureau of Maine's Elderly; one representative from
29 the Division of Community Services; one representa-
30 tive from the Department of Transportation; 2 repre-
31 sentatives from Maine's transportation providers and
32 a representative from an area agency on aging. The
33 appointments shall be made jointly by the President
34 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-
35 sentatives. The Department of Transportation and the
36 Office of Legislative Assistants shall serve as staff
37 for the review committee; and be it further

1 Sec. 2. Review and report. Resolved: That the
2 Social Services Transportation Review Committee shall
3 conduct a general review of the issue of social ser-
4 vices transportation and, by November 1, 1985, report
5 to the Legislature. That report shall include legis-
6 lation necessary to implement statutory changes and
7 appropriation requests to carry out the recommenda-
8 tions of the review committee; and be it further

9 Sec. 3. Payment of expenses. Resolved: The ex-
10 penses to the public members of the review committee
11 shall be paid from the Legislative Account.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The purpose of this resolve is to establish a So-
14 cial Services Transportation Review Committee.

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
