23 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
27 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

28 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will
29 become due and payable on or immediately after July
30 1, 1985; and

31 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
32 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
33 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
34 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
35 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
36 therefore,

1 Provides funding to
 2 establish new case
 3 aid positions to as-
 4 sist Vocational Re-
 5 habilitation Coun-
 6 selors in paper pro-
 7 cessing, scheduling
 8 of client services
 9 and routine evalua-
 10 tion activities.

25 Sec. 2. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations
 26 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-
 27 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-
 28 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
 29 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-
 30 ture and those reclassifications or range changes, or
 31 both, which have been approved by the Department of
 32 Personnel and submitted for legislative review prior
 33 to the effective date of this Act.

34 Sec. 3. Encumbered balance at year end. At the
 35 end of each fiscal year, all encumbered balances
 36 shall not be carried more than once.

37 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
 38 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July
 39 1, 1985.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to make supplemental allocations of the Federal Expenditure Fund for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987.

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
