20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §6722-A is enacted to read:

23 §6722-A. Limitation on taking of scallops during No-
24 vember

25 It is unlawful to fish for or take scallops with-
26 in 3 miles of the coastline between sunset and sun-
27 rise during the month of November.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the tak-
3 ing of scallops at night within 3 miles of the
4 coastline during the month of November.
