20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 1 MRSA c. 33 is enacted to read:

23 CHAPTER 33

24 DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN STATE PROPERTY

25 §2701. Removal or retention of state property

26 No elected official, state appointee or state em-
27 ployee may, upon the termination of his term of of-
28 fice, term of appointment or term of employment, re-
29 move or retain possession of any state property for
30 his own personal use or for use in another office,
31 appointed position or position of employment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to prohibit state of-
3 ficials, appointees or employees from keeping posses-
4 sion of any state property after they leave their of-
5 fice, appointment or employment.

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
