	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	CHAPTER 257
	INVESTIGATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS
	INVOLVING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS
	§2201. Definitions
	As used in this chapter, unless the context oth- erwise indicates, the following terms have the fol- lowing meanings.
	1. High speed chase. "High speed chase" means the pursuit by a law enforcement officer of a vehicle

- which is operated in excess of 20 miles per hour of
  the posted speed limit and for the purpose of escap ing apprehension by a law enforcement officer.
- 4 §2202. Investigation

5 The Commissioner of Public Safety shall investi-6 gate any motor vehicle accidents in the State which involve a motor vehicle operated by a state, county 7 or municipal law enforcement officer while on duty. 8 9 The purpose of the investigation shall be to deter-10 mine if excess speed or a high speed chase was causally related to the accident. 11

12 §2203. Report

13 If the commissioner determines that excess speed 14 or a high speed chase was a cause of the accident, he 15 shall issue a report of his findings to the state, 16 county or municipal agency having supervision over the law enforcement officer. The findings shall in-17 18 clude an assessment of the propriety and necessity of 19 the speed. These findings shall be kept on file and 20 shall be accessible to the public.

21 §2204. Use of report

A report pursuant to this chapter shall be in addition to any other report required by law or rule and may be used in legal or administrative action against a law enforcement officer.

## 26 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that the Commissioner of Public Safety investigate motor vehicle accidents involving law enforcement officers to determine if excess speed or a high speed chase may have caused the accident. The commissioner will report to the officer's supervisory unit.
