Amend the bill by striking out the title and in-
serting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide a Clothing Allowance for Needy
School Age Children.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything
after the enacting clause and inserting in its place
the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.
