STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the minimum reimbursement for each 6 credit hours of additional professional work that certified teachers are required to complete during a minimum of a 5-year period. The graduate tuition rate at the University of Maine at Orono is \$54 each credit hour. The effective date of this bill is set at August 31, 1986, so as not to interfere with any 1985-86 school budget. The cost of the change will be between \$1,000 and \$2,000 per year.

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
