14 15	'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2464, sub-§§2 and 3, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 399, §1, are amended to read:'
16 17 18 19	Further amend the bill in subsection 2, in the 2nd line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "installed" the following: 'and shall maintain in operational condition'
20 21	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
22 23 24 25 26	'3. Multiapartment buildings. In multiapartment buildings more than 3 stories in height, approved smoke detectors shall also be installed and maintained in operational condition in each closed corridor and closed hallway on each floor.
27 28 29	Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2464, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 399, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
30 31	5. Penalty. Whoever violates this section is guilty of a Class C crime.
