22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 37-B MRSA §504, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

25 5. Honor guard. The National Guard shall, upon
26 request, provide an honor guard for any burial ser-
27 vice within the cemetery.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to require that the National Guard provide an honor guard for any burial at the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery.

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
