17 AN ACT to Require the Teaching of Free
18 Enterprise in Maine's Public Schools.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §4601, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

23 1-A. Economics. A course in the free enterprise
24 system of economics shall be taught in at least one
25 grade from grades 9 to 12, in all public schools.

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

27 This bill requires that teaching on the subject
28 of the free enterprise system be included in Maine's
29 public school curriculum.
