20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 21 MRSA §602-A is enacted to read:

23 §602-A. Use of school facilities for polls

24 Upon request by the municipal officers of any mu-
25 nicipality where a school is located, the school ad-
26 ministrative unit shall permit the use of the school
27 or a portion of the school as a polling place.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to require that
3 school administrative units permit the use of school
4 facilities as polling places upon request of the mu-
5 nicipal officers of the municipality in which the
6 school is located.
