This bill reallocates the money already appropriated to establish a Lewiston campus of the University of Maine. The money would now be used by the University of Maine at Augusta to provide expanded programs and services at its Lewiston-Auburn Learning Center. money would be used to expand the baccalaureate program by offering degrees relevant to Androscoggin County citizens, such as nursing. It would also be used to provide library, laboratory and computer support for current and expanded programs, to acquire, renovate, heat and light necessary classroom space and to provide limited financial aid for needy students. The money would be used to provide a shuttle transportation service from the center to various points in Androscoggin County in order to enhance the availability of post-secondary educational services to county residents.
