- 1 <u>1. Permits. The commissioner may issue permits</u>
  2 <u>to import and possess live piranha to operators of public aquariums.</u>
- 4 2. Applications. An application for a permit under this section shall be on a form prepared and furnished by the commissioner and shall contain the following information:
- 8 A. The name and address of the applicant;
- 9 B. The location of the public aquarium;
- 10 C. Number of piranha to be imported;
- 11 D. The name and address of the seller;
- 12 E. Such certification as the commissioner may 13 establish certifying that the piranha show no ev-14 idence of disease; and
- F. Such other information as the commissioner may require.
- 3. Restriction. No person who posesses a permit issued under this section may:
- 19 A. Import or possess more than 10 piranha; or
- 20 B. Breed, sell or offer for sale any piranha.
- 4. Inspections. The department shall, at least once annually, inspect any aquarium possessing a permit under this section to determine if the permittee is in compliance with this section. The permittee shall, at the time of inspection or prior to any inspection, account for all piranha which he is permitted to possess under this section.

1	STATEMENT	OF	FACT	

2	The purpose of this bill is to allow the display
3	of piranha in public aquariums. The bill allows up
4	to 10 piranha per permit to be imported and dis-
5	played. The bill also provides for annual inspection
6	of all permittees and prohibits the sale or breeding
7	of piranha.
