17 AN ACT to Provide for the Negotiability of
18 Transfers, Reassignments and
19 Promotions for Teachers.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 20-A MRSa §13201, as amended by PL 1983, c. 806,
24 §93, is further amended by adding at the end a new
25 paragraph to read:

26 Transfer, reassignment and promotion of teachers
27 shall be negotiable items in accordance with the pro-
28 cedure set forth in Title 26, chapter 9-A, for teach-
29 ers.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The Maine Supreme Judicial Court case in Board of
3 Directors of Maine School Administrative District No.
4 36 v. Maine School Administrative District No. 36
5 Teachers Association ruled invalid a provision in a
6 collective bargaining agreement that transfer, reas-
7 signment and promotion of teachers are reserved to
8 the school board and superintendent and that school
9 boards cannot voluntarily enter into those provi-
10 sions.

11 This bill clarifies the law on negotiability of
12 these subjects.
