	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	20-A MRSA §13201, as amended by PL 1983, c. 806, §93, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
	Transfer, reassignment and promotion of teachers shall be negotiable items in accordance with the procedure set forth in Title 26, chapter 9-A, for teachers.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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The Maine Supreme Judicial Court case in Board of			
Directors of Maine School Administrative District No.			
36 v. Maine School Administrative District No. 36			
Teachers Association ruled invalid a provision in a			
collective bargaining agreement that transfer, reas-			
signment and promotion of teachers are reserved to			
the school board and superintendent and that school			
boards cannot voluntarily enter into those provi-			
sions.			

This bill clarifies the law on negotiability of these subjects.

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
