Reversion clause. Resolved: That, in the event that the Crisis and Counseling Center does not purchase the property at fair market value and this property should cease to be used by a nonprofit corporation for providing counseling or similar services, fee title to the land and buildings shall revert to the State.'

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This amendment corrects the property boundaries 15 in the resolve which reflects the boundaries prior to 16 the construction of Wade Street and other changes. In addition, this amendment allows the Commissioner of 17 Finance and Administration to negotiate a price with 18 the Crisis and Counseling Center or to convey the 19 property by gift. In the event that the Crisis and 20 21 Counseling Center does not pay fair market value for the property, the property must continue to be used for counseling or similar services or the property 22 23 24 reverts to the State.
