space on the temporary placard, fill in the date on which the placard shall expire. In no case may a temporary placard be provided for longer than a one-year period.

 Any temporary placard issued under this section may be displayed in any motor vehicle which the hand-icapped person to whom the placard was provided is operating, in which he is a passenger, in which he is being transported or which is waiting for a service to be rendered to the handicapped person. The temporary placard shall be so affixed that the information on the placard is clearly legible from outside the motor vehicle.

A person to whom a temporary placard has been issued under this section is entitled to the same rights and privileges as a person to whom a plate or placard is issued under section 252, during the term of that temporary placard.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for temporary handicapped placards which may be issued by physicians to their patients entitling them to handicapped parking privileges during the term of their incapacity.
