20 Respect to Purchases of Real Property.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 5 MRSA §1742, sub-§19, as amended by PL 1967, c.
25 307, is further amended to read:

26 19. Facilities required by State. To lease or
27 approve the leasing of grounds, buildings, facilities
28 and office space, except as provided in this subsection,
29 required by departments and agencies of the
30 State Government. No lease shall may be for a period
31 of more than 20 years. The Finance Authority of
32 Maine, the Maine State Retirement System and the
33 Maine State Housing Authority may not purchase, lease
34 or rent real property without the prior written ap-
35 proval of the Governor.
