23 Maine National Guard; study. Resolved: That the  
24 Department of Defense and Veterans' Services shall  
25 conduct a study of benefits offered by the Maine Na-  
26 tional Guard. The study shall compare these benefits  
27 to benefits offered in other states and shall make  
28 recommendations concerning the equalization of those  
29 benefits. The department shall report its findings,  
30 together with any implementing legislation, to the  
31 Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to require the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services to study Maine National Guard benefits and to make recommendations concerning the equalization of those benefits.

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
