21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 12 MRSA §6852, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

24 5. Exceptions. No license is required under  
25 this section for any establishment licensed under Ti-  
26 tle 22, chapter 562, to serve shellstock, lobsters,  
27 lobster parts, lobster meat or shellfish.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of this bill is to exempt eating es-  
3           tablishments which are licensed under the Maine Re-  
4           vised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 562 from having to  
5           purchase a retail seafood license in order to serve  
6           seafood.
