18 Fuel and Weatherization Assistance.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 22 MRSA §5206 is enacted to read:

23 §5206. Fraudulent representations; penalty

24 Any person who by means of a willfully false
25 statement or representation, or by impersonation or
26 other fraudulent devices, obtains or attempts to ob-
27 tain, or aids or abets any person to obtain aid to
28 which he is not entitled or a larger amount of aid
29 than that to which he is entitled under this chapter,
30 is guilty of a Class E crime.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to provide that any
3 fraudulent procurement of assistance under home
4 weatherization and fuel assistance programs shall be
5 a Class E crime.
