IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE
AN ACT to Establish an Increase in the Allowable Profit Margin for State Agency Liquor Stores.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
28 MRSA §204, 2nd ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983, c. 824, Pt. W, is amended to read:
The commission shall sell to agency stores spiri- tuous and vinous liquor, except table wine, for a price of $\frac{10\%}{11\%}$ less than the retail price estab- lished for the state retail stores, provided that the discount shall not apply to federal taxes levied on or after November 1, 1941.

2	This bill increases the profit margin for state
3	agency liquor stores by increasing the discount at
4	which the State Liquor Commission will sell to agency
