STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that when a tenant wins a 2 court action for a landlord's violation of the war-3 4 ranty of habitability the court shall award attorney's fees to the person bringing the successful com-plaint. The bill also provides that any violation of 5 6 7 the landlord tenant laws shall be considered an unfair trade practice, subject to court action either 8 9 by the individual parties or by the Attorney General in cases affecting many people. 10

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
