15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22	Deputies shall be originally appointed for a probationary period of not more than 6 months and thereafter may be appointed or reappointed for a term of 3 years. Failure of a sheriff to reappoint a deputy, except for appointment at expiration of the probationary period, shall be subject to the procedures and standards for dismissal of an applicable collective bargaining agreement.
23	STATEMENT OF FACT
24 25 26 27 28 29	This amendment eliminates the provision of the bill which requires that all persons who deal with prisoners shall be deputy sheriffs. It simplifies the wording of the sections dealing with reappointment of deputies and eliminates the subject of initial appointment.

It is realized that certain deputies will not qualify for the provisions of the bill, since they will not qualify as public employees and, thus, not be under collective bargaining. Chief deputies and part-time deputies are most likely not to qualify.
