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COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
321, L.D. 810, "Resolve, to Establish a Commission to
Prepare a Revision of the State's Motor Vehicle
Laws."

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Amend the resolve in the 10th paragraph after the
Title in the 2nd line (page 2, line 23 in L.D.) by
striking out the number "5" and inserting in its
place the number '7' and in the 9th line (page 2,
line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Le-
gal Affairs;" and inserting in its place the follow-
ing: 'Transportation; one member shall be chosen by
the Commissioner of Transportation to represent the
Department of Transportation; one member shall be
chosen by the Commissioner of Public Safety to repre-
sent the Department of Public Safety;'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of
the 15th paragraph after the Title (page 3, lines 21
to 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the follow-
ing:

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'Staff; duties; report. Resolved: That the Of-
fice of Legislative Assistants shall provide staff
assistance to the commission and that the Director of
Legislative Assistants, in consultation with the com-
mission, may, by contract, hire an attorney and any
additional staff necessary to accomplish the purpose
of this resolve, but the total expenditures of the
commission shall not exceed the sum provided in this
resolve; and be it further'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of
the next to the last and last paragraphs before the
emergency clause (page 4, lines 5 to 15 in L.D.) and
inserting in their place the following:

1 'Report to the Legislature. Resolved: That the
2 commission present its report and revision of the
3 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, to the Joint Stand-
4 ing Committee on Transportation and to the 113th Leg-
5 islature; and be it further

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COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 321, L.D. 810

1 This conference committee amendment will provide sub-
2 stantial cost savings and will avoid duplication of
3 effort in preparing the revision. The conference
4 committee amendment also reduces the allocation to
5 \$15,000 to reflect the savings. It is estimated that
6 \$5,000 of this allocation will be required for per
7 diem, public notice and printing costs of the commis-
8 sion. This conference committee amendment also adds
9 2 more state agency representatives to the recodifi-
10 cation committee.
