17 AN ACT Relating to Prostitution.

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
20 follows:

21 17-A MRSA §851, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1975, c.  
22 499, §1, is amended to read:

23 1. "Prostitution" means engaging in, or agreeing  
24 to engage in, or offering to engage in sexual inter-  
25 course or a sexual act or in sexual contact, as de-  
26 fined in chapter 11, section 251, in return for a pe-  
27 cuniary benefit to be received by the person engaging  
28 in prostitution or a 3rd person;

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This bill recognizes that prostitutes can and  
3 have been offering to engage in digital contact with  
4 the patron's sex organs in return for a pecuniary  
5 benefit.

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
