14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that the bill concerns only prior Maine convictions for theft-like offenses and not prior convictions for those offenses committed outside of Maine. Trying to address prior out-of-state convictions under the theft enhancement provisions dealt with in the bill would prove difficult given that the criminal codes of other states are not identical to Maine's Criminal Code.
