27 28	'Sec. 8. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on September 30, 1986.'

32	The purpose of this amendment is to delay the ef-

fective date of the Act until September 30, 1986 which will be just prior to the dead-line set by the 1 2 Federal Government for compliance with national minimum drinking age. 5 Delay of the effective date will alleviate many of the problems which the higher drinking age will 7 pose to colleges and universities, to small grocers and to persons charged with enforcing the liquor 9 statutes. It will also provide sufficient notice of 10 the pending change to those who will be affected by 11 it. 12 4385061485
