## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The Potato Price Stabilization Program was estab-3 lished by the Legislature in 1983, by Public Law 4 1983, chapter 582, to address the problem of fluctua-5 tions in potato prices which cause sever instability 6 in the industry.

7 The Legislature authorized the program for a test 8 period, with a repeal provision effective June 1, 9 1986. The industry believes the test period has proven highly successful and that the information be-10 11 ing generated is critically important to farmers in 12 making accurate marketing decisions. It is essential 13 that this program be continued for an additional pe-14 riod of time. This proposal extends the sunset pro-15 vision from June 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987.

16 Originally, Public Law 1983, chapter 582 provided 17 for a handler licensing fee to fund the program. 18 This was repealed in 1984. Since there is no longer 19 dedicated revenue for funding, the Governor has in-20 cluded funds in the 1984-85 and 1985-86 Part II bud-21 get to replace handler fees to fund the program.

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
