The Chester Dental Clinic is now in its 15th year of serving residents of North-central Penobscot County. Since its inception, the clinic has focused its services on dentally indigent children. Last year, over 2/3 of those served by the clinic were under 19 years old while over 93% of the total number of patients served were subsidized through reduced fees.

Until October 1, 1984, the Chester Dental Clinic was a part of the National Health Services Corps Program. Due to recent cutbacks in financial support for the United States Public Health Service, in fiscal year 1986-87, the Chester Dental Clinic will need \$24,000 in financial support in order to continue to offer the same level of services to approximately 1,000 patients which it serves each year.

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
