10 11 12 13	Amend the bill in subsection 1 by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence (page 1, lines 28 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the follow- ing:
14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	'A public school designated as especially needy shall be required to hold a public hearing during the school year 1985-86 to determine if there is parental interest for their school to participate in the Na- tional School Breakfast Program. After July 1, 1986, schools designated as especially needy shall hold a public hearing to determine if there is parental in- terest in participating in the National School Breakfast program on petition of 10% of the parents of students in the school. Schools are not required to hold public hearings on participation more often than once every 2 years.'
26	STATEMENT OF FACT

27 This amendment eliminates the mandate that 28 schools in which 50% or more of the children are eligible for free or reduced price meals (schools desig-29 30 nated as especially needy) participate in the National School Breakfast Program. It replaces the mandate 31 with the requirement that these schools hold a public hearing in the 1985-86 school year to assess the in-terests of parents in a school breakfast program. It 32 33 34 35 also provides a mechanism whereby 10% of the parents 36 in a school designated as especially needy may petition the school to hold a public hearing if the 37
