20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8102, as enacted by PL 1981,
23 c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.

24 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §8102-A is enacted to read:

25 §8102-A. School administrative units to establish
26 program

27 1. Establishment. Each school administrative
28 unit shall, commencing with the 1987-88 school year,
29 establish a gifted education program.

30 2. Guidelines for the identification of gifted
31 and talented students. The commissioner shall adopt
32 or amend rules for the identification of gifted and
33 talented students and for gifted and talented educa-
34 tion programs.
