Whereas, Acts and resolves 19 of Legislature do not become effective until 90 days 20 after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 21 Whereas, there presently exists a number of va-22 cant buildings at Pineland Center; and Whereas, it is the responsibility of the State to effectively use all of its existing resources; and 23 24 25 Whereas, existing public and private resources are not adequate to meet the needs and potential of 26 27 the State's citizens; and 28 Whereas, the unused public buildings at Pineland 29 Center may be a resource which could help meet those 30 needs: and 31 Whereas, the members of the 112th Legislature find that a coordinated effort utilizing the re-sources and expertise of both the public and private 32 33 sectors is necessary in addressing this problem to 34

1 the benefit of all citizens of the State; and

2 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 3 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 4 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 5 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-6 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 7 therefore, be it

8 Commission established. Resolved: That a Special Commission to Study the Utilization of Vacant Build-ings at Pineland Center be created. The commission 9 10 shall consist of 13 members as follows: One member to 11 12 the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speak-13 er of the House of Representatives; one member of the 14 Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; the 15 Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation 16 his designee; the Director of Public Improvements or 17 or his designee; 9 members appointed by the Governor, 18 including one representative of the Board of Visi-19 tors, Pineland Center; one representative of the Consumer Advisory Board for the Mentally Retarded; one 20 representative of Pineland Parents and Friends; 21 one 22 representative of the Maine State Employees Association; one representative of the American Federation 23 24 of State, County and Municipal Employees; a represen-25 tative from the Town of Gray; a representative from 26 the Town of New Gloucester; a representative of the 27 Bureau of Maine's Elderly; and a representative of 28 the Maine State Housing Authority.

29 The members shall be appointed in a timely manner 30 and the commission shall hold an organizational meet-31 ing at the call of the chairman of the Legislative 32 Counsel within 30 days after the effective date of this resolve. At this meeting, the commission 33 shall 34 elect a chairman and vice-chairman from within the 35 membership. Members who are not state employees shall 36 receive expenses for meals and travel in accordance 37 with Title 5, chapter 377; and be it further

Develop a plan which indentifies: 11 A. Potential occupants who would use any space 12 13 that is identified as valuable; and 14 B. Recommendations for financiang needed 15 renovations of existing space, including a 16 cost-benefit analysis for additional investment 17 of state funds; and be it further 18 Staff support. Resolved: That the Department of 19 Mental Health and Mental Retardation and Bureau of 20 Public Improvements shall provide staff support to 21 this commission. 22 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 23 in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when 24 approved. 25 FISCAL NOTE 26 The costs associated with the special commission 27 may be absorbed within existing resources of the De-28 partment of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.'
