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AN ACT to Authorize an Elderly Housing  
Project at Pineland Center.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

34-B MRSA §5402-A is enacted to read:

§5402-A. Elderly housing project

1. Project authorized. The superintendent may establish a low income housing project for the elderly at the Pineland Center. He may evaluate existing buildings at the center and convert buildings, which are currently not used or not fully used, for the needs of the center into residential units for the elderly.

2. Criteria. The superintendent may by rule establish criteria for admission to low-income housing for the elderly established pursuant to this section. One such criterion shall be that residents in the

1 project shall participate in such volunteer work at  
2 or for the center as the superintendent may provide.

3 3. Funds. The superintendent is authorized to  
4 accept funds for conversion of buildings under this  
5 section and for administration and maintenance costs  
6 of this project from any federal, state, municipal or  
7 private source. He may request an appropriation from  
8 the Legislature for any project proposed under this  
9 section.

10 STATEMENT OF FACT

11 The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Su-  
12 perintendent of Pineland Center to establish a  
13 low-cost elderly housing project at Pineland. Resi-  
14 dents in the project would be required to participate  
15 in volunteer work at the center.

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
