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§261. C	ompliance	with pr	ocedure	s required	
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1 §262. Notice

 At least 24 hours prior to making any inspection or investigation as provided in section 261, the state official or agency shall notify, in writing, the owner or administrator of the health care facility of the official's or agency's intention to visit the facility and the time of that visit.

§263. Persons present during inspection or investigation

If any state officials or personnel of any state agency conduct an investigation or inspection as provided in section 261, they shall inform the owner or administrator of the facility that the owner or administrator and one staff employee selected by the owner or administrator shall have the right to be present at all times during that inspection or investigation.

§264. Number of inspectors or investigators

No inspection or investigation visit may be conducted under this chapter unless there are at least 2 state officials or agency personnel present at the facility to conduct the inspection or investigation.

23 §265. Time of inspection or investigation

No inspection or investigation may be conducted under this chapter except during the normal business hours of the facility being inspected or investigated.

§266. Exception

Notwithstanding this chapter, an inspection or investigation visit may be conducted without complying with the requirements of section 262 or 265 if the state official or agency conducting the inspection or investigation finds that an emergency exists such that the requirements of those sections cannot reasonably be met prior to making the inspection or investigation. The reasons for the emergency shall be set out in writing and shall be provided to the owner or administrator of the facility being in-
