17 AN ACT to Exempt Houses of Worship from
18 Inspection Fees for Elevators.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 26 MRSA §490-A, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1977,
23 c. 543, §4, is amended to read:

24 Each elevator or tramway proposed to be used
25 within this State shall be thoroughly inspected by
26 either the supervising inspector, a state inspector
27 or a licensed inspector, and if found to conform to
28 the rules of the board, upon payment of the inspec-
29 tion fee where required and a certificate fee of \$5
30 per year by the owner or user of such elevator or
31 tramway, the board shall issue to such owner or user
32 an inspection certificate. No inspection fee or cer-
33 tificate fee may be assessed for any elevator located
34 in a house of religious worship. The certificate
35 shall specify the maximum load to which such convey-
36 ance shall be subjected, the date of its issuance and

1 the date of its expiration. Such elevator certifi-
2 cates shall be posted in the elevator and the tramway
3 certificate at a conspicuous place in the machine ar-
4 ea.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to exempt elevators
7 located in houses of religious worship from the in-
8 spection fees and certificate fees upon inspection of
9 those elevators.
