20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 1 MRSA c. 33 is enacted to read:

23 CHAPTER 33

24 RETENTION OF STATE PROPERTY

25 §2701. Retention of state property by state offi-  
26 cial, appointees or employees

27 No person elected to state office, serving in an  
28 appointed position in State Government or employed by  
29 the State may upon leaving that office or position  
30 retain control or possession of any state property  
31 for his own personal use or for use in any other of-  
32 fice or position.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to prevent state officials, appointees and employees from retaining any state property after leaving that office or position.

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
